## 92nd Novena of Grace - March 9th through March 17th "Finding Peace in Our Time; Increasing Faith, Hope and Love"

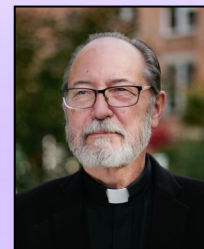
